

Quick Reference Guide



GATS key terms

The following are key defined terms within GATS e-documents

Advance Requirements

- Conditions precedent to assignment under the lease agreement, and/or the conditions precedent to release of existing security interests
- Copied onto the GATS Platform and the beneficiary of the conditions confirms electronically when satisfied

GATS e-Ledger

- The computer system which records the name of each GATS Beneficiary each GATS Trustee and each GATS transaction
- · Fully searchable for an administrative fee

GATS Beneficiary

- The beneficiary of a GATS Trust
- Each GATS Beneficiary will need to set up a user account and accept the GATS e-Terms

GATS Platform

- The portal, the website and the related computerised systems, including the GATS e-Ledger
- On 29 March 2019, AWG and Fexco announced their agreement to collaborate on the GATS Platform

GATS Secured Party

- The person who is a secured party under a GATS Security Instrument i.e. the security trustee
- Such secured party may also hold security interests in the GATS Trust outside of the GATS Platform

GATS Trust

- · A trust created on the GATS Platform
- The name of the trust will be "GATS Trust [###]"
- Created under the laws of USA (Delaware/Utah), Singapore or Ireland

GATS Trustee

- The trustee of the GATS Trust, which will be a professional trust company established in one of Delaware (USA), Utah (USA), Singapore or Ireland
- The GATS Trustee acts as lessor under the lease

Servicer

- The servicer/lease manager under the lease
- There will be a Servicer as the lessor is an owner trustee
- The Servicer will need to be replaced outside of GATS as part of a GATS trade

GATS key e-documents

The following are non-negotiable standard forms

GATS e-Terms

Between: (1) all users; and (2) the GATS Platform

Overarching standard terms that apply to users of the GATS Platform (i.e. GATS Trustee, GATS Beneficiary, GATS Secured Party)

Similar to website "standard terms", each user accepts the e-Terms one-time-only when they set up an account with the GATS Platform

The e-Terms set out the framework for:

- · establishment of GATS Trusts
- · migration of existing trusts into GATS
- · entry of transactions into the e-Ledger
- · transfers outside of GATS

GATS Trust Instrument Master Terms

Long-form master terms applicable to each GATS Trust Instrument covering:

- · ownership/administration of the trust estate
- · distribution of income and proceeds
- · actions by GATS Trustee upon instructions
- · duties of the GATS Trustee
- · representations, warranties and covenants
- · disclaimers and limitation of liability
- · assignment and transfer

GATS Trust Instrument

Between (1) Trustee and (2) Beneficiary

Short-form document incorporating the GATS Trust Instrument Master Terms

Creates the GATS Trust for the relevant Aircraft Equipment

The following need to be completed:

- · Description of GATS Trust
- · Parties and Notice Details
- Aircraft Equipment
- Description of Trust Documents



GATS Transfer Instrument

(Full Beneficial Interest Transfer)

Between (1) Existing Beneficiary, (2) New Beneficiary and (3) Trustee

Short-form document incorporating the GATS Trust Instrument Master Terms

Transfers the beneficial interest in a GATS Trust

This replaces the lease novation agreement and contains:

- assignment and transfer mechanics (giving a "clean break" at the effective time, so the buyer only takes on liabilities thereafter)
- title warranty in relation to the GATS Trust and (subject to Permitted Encumbrances) the Aircraft Equipment

The following need to be completed:

- · Description of GATS Trust
- · Parties and Notice Details
- Transfer Details (Aircraft Equipment, Ownership of Aircraft Equipment Representation, Permitted Encumbrances, Transferred Related Documents)
- · Amendments to Description of GATS Trust Documents

There is a separate form for a partial/residual beneficial interest transfer



GATS Amendment Instrument (GATS Trust Instrument)

Between (1) Beneficiary and (2) Trustee

Short-form document incorporating the GATS Trust Instrument Master Terms

Effects a list of permitted administrative amendments to a GATS Trust:

- · Amendments to Aircraft Equipment
- · Amendments to Description of Previous Trust Documents
- · Amendments to Description of GATS Trust Documents

GATS Termination Instrument

Between (1) Beneficiary and (2) Trustee

Short-form document incorporating the GATS Trust Instrument Master Terms

Terminates a GATS Trust as of a specified effective time and transfers the trust estate to a specified transferee



GATS Security Instrument Master Terms

Long-form master terms applicable to each GATS Security Instrument covering:

- · representations, warranties and covenants
- · enforcement remedies
- · application of proceeds
- · assignment and transfer
- · amendments and waivers
- typical security boilerplate provisions

GATS Security Instrument

Between (1) Beneficiary, (2) Secured Party and (3) Trustee

Short-form document incorporating the GATS Security Instrument Master Terms

Assignment and charge of all interest in the trust estate under a GATS Trust and proceeds thereof in favour of the relevant GATS Secured Party

The following need to be completed:

- · Description of GATS Trust
- · Parties and Notice Details
- · Principal Finance Document
- · Principal Security Agreement
- · Priority of Payment Provisions
- · Limited Purpose Covenants
- · Description of GATS Security Documents



GATS Security Transfer Instrument

Between (1) Existing Secured Party and (2) New Secured Party

Short-form document incorporating the GATS Security Instrument Master Terms

Effects a change in the GATS Secured Party under a GATS Security Instrument, avoiding the need to release and re-take the security interest in favour of the new secured party

The following need to be completed:

- · Description of GATS Trust
- · Parties and Notice Details
- Amendments to Description of GATS Security Documents

GATS Release, Discharge & Reassignment

Between (1) Beneficiary and (2) Secured Party

Short-form document incorporating the GATS Security Instrument Master Terms

Releases and re-assigns (without recourse or warranty) the security created by a GATS Security Instrument and terminates the same

The following need to be completed:

- Description of GATS Trust
- · Parties and Notice Details
- · Description of GATS Security Documents



GATS transaction timeline


The flow chart below sets out the main steps from creation of the trust through to trade

- Choose GATS Trustee & location (Ireland, Singapore or USA)
- GATS e-Terms: create GATS user account & accept e-Terms
- GATS Trust Instrument: create GATS Trust or migrate existing trust onto the GATS Platform
- Enter into beneficial interest sale and purchase agreement for the Aircraft Equipment (as usual, outside of the GATS Platform)
- Advance Requirements: transcribe conditions to lease assignment / release of existing security onto GATS Platform
- Parties work towards satisfaction of conditions to lease assignment / release of existing security
- Advance Requirements: beneficiaries (airline/secured party) confirm electronically on the GATS Platform that conditions satisfied
- Advance Requirements Certificate: issued by GATS Platform to confirm satisfaction of Advance Requirements
- GATS Transfer Instrument: access GATS Platform and complete the missing information: Parties and Notice Details, Transfer Details, Amendments etc.
- e-signature and e-delivery: Existing Beneficiary, New Beneficiary and GATS
 Trustee e-sign and e-deliver the Transfer Instrument and effective time occurs
- GATS e-Ledger: transfer recorded on the GATS Platform (which may be on a blockchain network)




GATS structure diagrams
