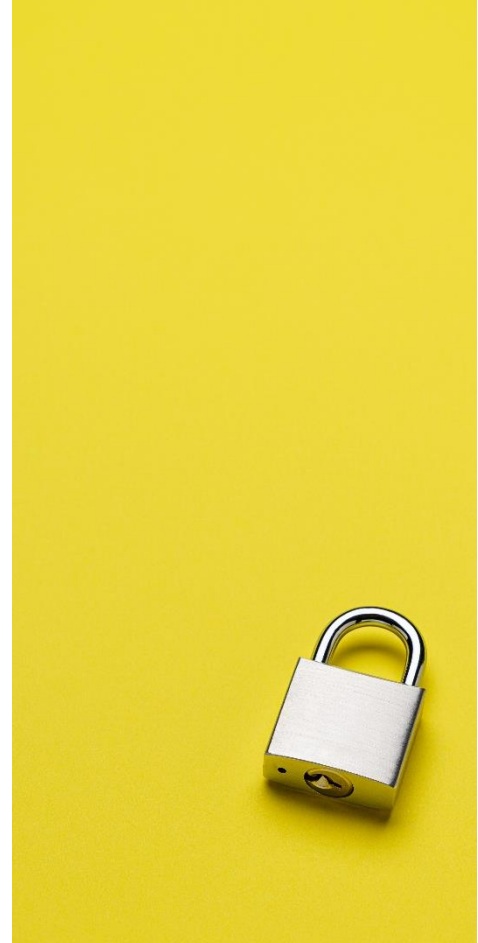
Facing the threat

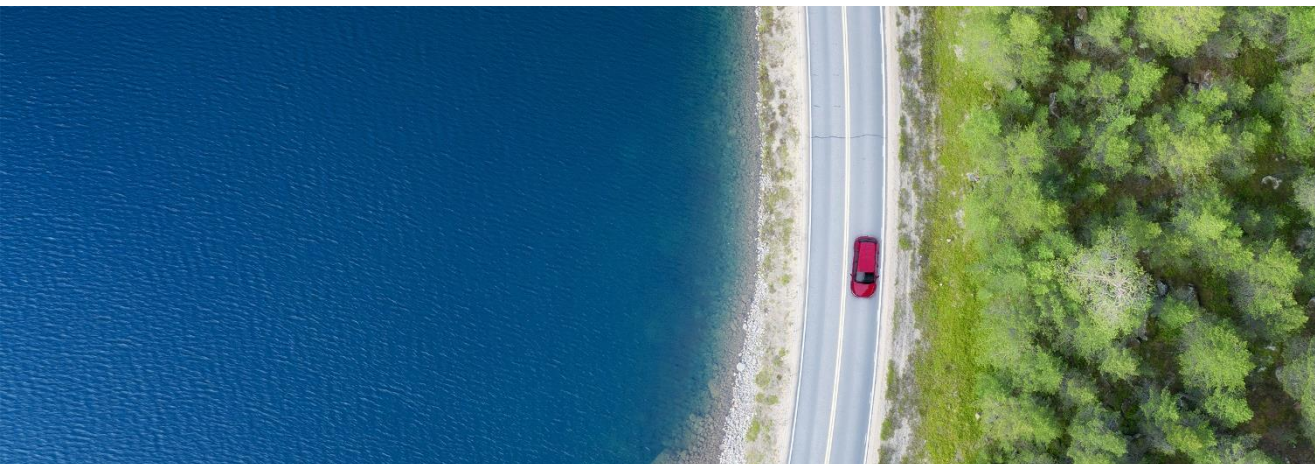
